By-Law No. 1929-14 – Being a By-Law to Adopt an Official Plan Amendment to the Official Plan of the Municipality of Red Lake.

The Council of The Corporation of the Municipality of Red Lake gave 1st and 2nd reading to the following By-Law at the Regular Council Meeting held on Monday, September 15th, 2014:

By-Law No. 1930-14 – Being a By-Law to Regulate the Use of Land and the Character, Location and Use of Buildings and Structures and to Prohibit Certain Uses, Buildings and Structures in Various Defined Areas of the Municipality of Red Lake. (Zoning By-Law)

Commencing September 15th, Northern Waterworks will be flushing hydrants at various locations within the Red Lake Community.

Please note that the following may occur:

1. Discolouration of the drinking water, if so run tap water until the water clears.
2. A minimal difference in pressure may occur which could cause leaks if YOUR HOT WATER TANK is on the verge of failure. If you feel that this may be the case, it is recommended that you isolate your tank during the above mentioned periods.

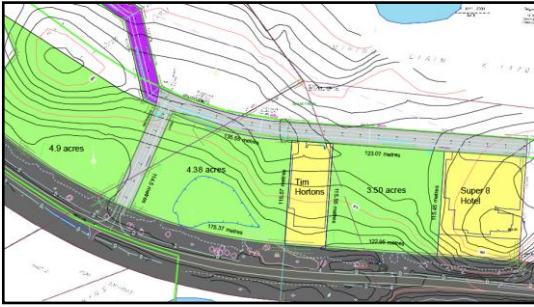

The Municipality of Red Lake has declared 12.78 acres of Highway Commercial property surplus and is available for sale to the public. The property is fully serviced with a paved road, electrical, water, force main sewer, telephone, cable and internet available to the lot line. The property is being sold by "Reference Plan" and as such the purchaser can select the amount of property they require for their business and is responsible to survey their property selection. The map above indicates the approximate acreages of development area (4.9, 4.38 and 3.50 acres) and is zoned C4 (Highway Commercial). The property is selling for \$55,700 an acre plus applicable taxes.

Thanks to Government funding 3.5 acres of Highway Commercial between Tim Hortons and Super 8 is being prepared to rough final grade – without cost to potential investors. Upon site completion the Municipality anticipates considerable interest from investors. Please call to discuss the potential of locating a business to all or a portion of this property.
