Carbon Monoxide Alarms Now Required in Homes

Beat the Silent Killer: Prevent CO in Your Home



It's now the law in Ontario to install carbon monoxide (CO) alarms in your home. If you have a fuel burning appliance or an attached garage, you must have a working CO alarm outside all sleeping areas of the home.

Single family homeowners and owners of residential buildings that contain no more than six suites have until April 15, 2015 to comply with the law. Owners of residential buildings with more than six suites have until October 15, 2015 to comply.

Failure to comply with the CO alarm requirements could result in a fine of up to \$50,000 for individuals and \$100,000 for corporations.

The Ontario Fire Code also requires that in condo and apartment buildings with a service room, CO alarms must be installed in the service room and outside all sleeping areas of all homes above, below and beside the service room. In condo and apartment buildings that have a garage, CO alarms must be installed outside all sleeping areas of all homes above, below and beside the garage.

Every driver has a responsibility to direct their entire attention to driving safely.

Distracted driving refers to all forms of distracted or inattentive driving such as adjusting a vehicle's entertainment or GPS unit or stereo, eating, drinking, using hand-held devices, self-grooming or tending to children in the backseat, etc. Drivers need to remember that the true danger to public safety lies in the distraction, not the device.

In 2013, the OPP investigated 78 fatalities in which distracted driving was a casual factor. 19,000 distracted driving charges were laid in Ontario in 2013.

Red Lake OPP has seen an increase in impaired driving occurrences. In 2014 there have been 35 criminal charges laid related to impaired driving. This is a 46% increase (24 – 35) from this time last year.

The OPP rely on the public to report crime and impaired driving is a crime that should be treated no differently. If you suspect someone is driving or about to drive impaired, call 9-1-1 and report it.

If you plan on drinking, plan to not drive. Instead, arrange for a designated driver, take a taxi or stay overnight.
