Snow & Ice Removal By-Law

Please be aware that the Municipality of Red Lake has a Snow & Ice Removal By-Law (By-Law No. 935-07).



By-Law 935-07 states the following:

- No person shall deposit or cause to be deposited any snow or ice upon any portion of any municipal roadway or municipal sidewalk located within the territorial limits of The Corporation of the Municipality of Red Lake.
- No person shall relocate snow within the street allowance in such a manner as to encroach on the cleared portion of the street allowance intended for vehicular and pedestrian traffic, or that would result in the obstruction of normal visibility of the safe movement of vehicular and pedestrian traffic on the street allowance.

Any person that contravenes any provisions of this By-Law may be subject to a fine.

Feeding Nuisance Animals

No person shall feed nuisance animals on any public or private property within the boundaries of the Municipality of Red Lake. No person shall scatter or cause to scatter food, of any type, on any public or private property for any nuisance animal within the boundaries of the Municipality of Red Lake.

“Nuisance Animals” means any type of non-domesticated animal that may become a nuisance to the public which include, but not limited to coyotes, bears, foxes, ravens, or crows.
