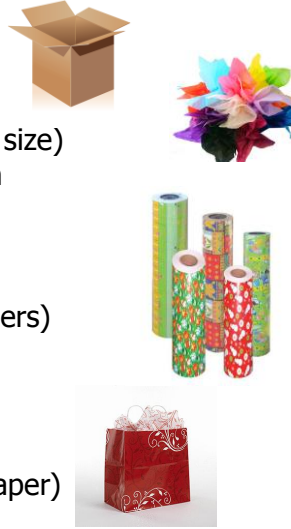

Christmas is around the corner and there will be lots of questions as to what is recyclable and what is not recyclable.

Below is a list of common holiday waste:



**Recyclable:**

- Cardboard boxes (bundled to less than 1m in size)
- Boxboard – (plastic windows not marked with recyclable symbol must be removed)
- Tissue paper
- Brown paper wrapping paper
- Tin containers (ie. cookie & chocolate containers)
- Christmas Trees – free disposal at landfill and curbside (see page 3).

**Non-Recyclable:**

- Gift bags & Wrapping paper (except brown paper)
- Paper towel
- Aluminum foil (ie. roasters, pie plates, cookie sheets, tin foil)
- Combination containers (both cardboard & metal)

**Christmas Tree Curbside Collection**

**Wednesday, January 14<sup>th</sup>, 2015.**



Trees have to be cut in half and no plastic bags or they will not be collected.

Please do not place your Christmas tree on the curbside until the evening before or the day of collection. If the tree has been plowed into the snow bank and not easily accessible, it will not be collected.

If you wish to dispose of your Christmas tree prior to this date, you may bring it to the Municipal Landfill for **FREE** during normal operating hours.
