Snowmobile & ATV Speed Limits

The Red Lake Police Services Board in conjunction with the Ontario Provincial Police are asking snowmobilers and ATV enthusiasts to increase their efforts to ride within the law.

Speed limits must be obeyed. The provincial speed limits for snowmobilers and off road vehicles are:

- 50 km/h on a trail;
- 20 km/h on highways with automobile speed limits of 50 km/h or less;
- 50 km/h on highways with automobile speed limits of more than 50 km/h



Please note that all roadways within our Municipality are considered highways under the Act

House Numbers

The Municipality of Red Lake has a Numbering By-Law in place. Numbers are required to be on homes. For rural property, numbers are to be at the beginning of the drive way. The numbers allow emergency response units to respond quickly and efficiently. Consider what could happen if they were unable to locate your home in a timely manner.

House Numbers are required in both Urban and Rural areas.

The Municipality has numbers available for pick-up at the Municipal Office.

Failure to install/maintain the house number may result in the Municipality entering upon the property to install/maintain a house number at the owner's expense. The By-Law Department will be inspecting all homes this spring and installing numbers if required.

In particular, those that are most vulnerable in an emergency situation: the elderly, disabled, those with special medical requirements, those who live alone, have no local support network or means of transportation, etc. should complete an Emergency Registration Form.

The Clerk's Office maintains a listing of the Emergency Registration Forms. If you completed an Emergency Registration Form in 2014, you are not required to complete another one, unless your information requires an update.
