## Notice of Correction – Fees for Fire Permits

By-Law No. 1295-10 states that fire permits are required for burning during the fire season (April 1<sup>st</sup> to October 31<sup>st</sup>) within Municipal boundaries. The conditions of the By-Law shall be complied with and a Fire Permit shall be purchased. **There is to be no day burning during the fire season.** In accordance with the User Fees and Charges By-Law (By-Law No. 1945-14) the fees for fire permits during the 2015 fire season are as follows:

Type of Fire Permit	Conditions	2015 Fees
Annual Permit	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Campfire burned in single pile <b>no larger</b> than 0.7 m in diameter by 0.7 m high;</li> <li>• Commercial fire pots (ex. Chimineas); and</li> <li>• Valid for current fire season.</li> </ul>	\$40.00 (Permit)
Level 1 Permit	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Material burned in single pile <b>no larger</b> than 2 m in diameter by 2 m high; and</li> <li>• Valid for 4 consecutive days, including date issued.</li> </ul>	\$10.00 (Permit)
Level 2 Permit	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Material burned in pile <b>larger</b> than 2 m in diameter by 2 m high;</li> <li>• <b>Inspection and approval required;</b> and</li> <li>• Valid for 4 consecutive days, including the date issued.</li> </ul>	\$10.00 (Permit) \$35.00 (Inspection)
Incinerator Permit	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Enclosed device constructed of non-combustible material;</li> <li>• Covered with screen having a mesh size of not more than 1/8";</li> <li>• <b>Inspection and approval required;</b> and</li> <li>• Valid for current fire season.</li> </ul>	\$40.00 (includes Permit & Inspection)

Construction season is fast approaching! Depending on the development being considered, approval of a planning application may be required in order to obtain a building permit.

The timeframe required for circulation and review of a planning application can be 2 to 6 months. If you are considering building or have a development project for the 2015 construction season, it is recommended that you submit your application early.
