Thefts from Unlocked Vehicles - Balmertown

Impaired Driving – Red Lake & Balmertown

There has been an increase in impaired driving occurrences when comparing data from 2014 to 2013. Impaired driving remains the leading cause of criminal death in Canada.

If you suspect that someone is driving or about to drive impaired, call 9-1-1 and report it. If you see that someone is impaired and intends on driving, do not let them drive.



Automobile Speed Limits for Municipal Roadways



Residents are reminded that the automobile speed limit within all municipal town sites is 40 km/h (exception of Hwy 125 & Hwy 618).

Pursuant to By-Law No. 1235-09 “No person shall drive a motor vehicle at a greater rate of speed than forty (40) kilometers per hour on any highway under the jurisdiction of the Municipality of Red Lake.”

ATV & Off Road Vehicles Speed Limits for Municipal Roadways

Provincial speed limits for ATV's and off road vehicles are:

- 50 km/h on a trail;
- **20 km/h on highways with automobile speed limits of 50 km/h or less;**
- 50 km/h on highways with automobile speed limits of more than 50 km/h
