Reminder for Dog Owners
By-Law No. 1877-14

Section 2.1 states no person residing within the limits of the Municipality shall own a dog without obtaining an annual license as required by the above noted By-Law and every owner of a dog shall be subject to the provisions of the By-Law.

Licenses are available for purchase at the Municipal Office on Fifth Street in Balmertown.

Failure to adhere to this section may result in a set fine of \$50.00 per dog.



Section 5.1 states no person shall suffer, allow or permit any dog to run at large within the limits of the Municipality of Red Lake.

Failure to adhere to this section may result in a set fine of \$100.00 plus applicable pound fees.

Section 5.7 states no person shall suffer, allow or permit a dog to defecate on private or public property without immediate removal.



Failure to adhere to this section of the By-Law may result in a fine of \$100.00

Garbage Collection Reminder

Section 5.12 of By-Law No. 1376-10 states the **designated pickup point shall be within 1 meter of the traveled road, lane or curb as may best facilitate collection.** Continued non-compliance may result in materials being left at curbside.
