NOTICE OF PUBLIC MEETING #2 Red Lake Trails Engineering Study

THE STUDY

The Municipality of Red Lake has retained Hatch Mott MacDonald to undertake a Trails Engineering Study with the goal to develop a trail system that will link the communities of Red Lake, Balmertown, Cochenour, Madsen and Starratt Olsen.

The Trails Engineering Study's purpose is to gather and develop the following:

- Feedback from consultation with the community, user groups and agencies;
- Trail alignment alternatives and implementation phasing;
- Cost estimates and funding sources;
- Summary report, including suggested signage and interpretative features.

BEAR ENCOUNTERS – WHO DO I CALL?

Emergency Situations

Call 911 if a black bear poses an immediate threat to personal safety by exhibiting threatening or aggressive behavior, such as:

- Entering a school yard when school is in session.
- Stalking people and is lingering at the site.
- Entering or trying to enter a residence.
- Wandering into a public gathering.
- Killing livestock/pets and is lingering at the site.

Non-Emergency Encounters

Call the toll-free Bear Wise reporting line at 1-866-514-2327 (TTY 705-945-7641) if a black bear is:

- In a tree.
- Pulling down a bird feeder or knocking over a barbecue.
- Moving through a backyard or field but is not lingering.

This line operates 24 hours a day, seven days a week from April 1st until November 30th.

Reminder to Residents

Human - Wildlife Encounters Ages 6-11 and \$8 per workshop members \$7 per workshop.

Residents are reminded to not make available food attractants or other substances for the consumption by wildlife. Attractants include, but are not limited to: food products, garbage, pet food, grain, salt, pellets, pet feces or fallen fruit.

Residents are also reminded to place their garbage on the curbside the day of collection and not prior to.

This is in accordance to the Feeding of Wildlife and Waste Management By-Laws.
