NOTICE – MOTORIZED SNOW VEHICLE ROUTES

The following named municipal highways shall only be used as access highways for motorized snow vehicles to leave and return to the town sites:

As per By-Law No. 108-00, no person shall operate a motorized snow vehicle upon any highway and/or area under the jurisdiction of the Municipality, except for the above noted highways. These highways are to be used as access roads to the trails only. You must use the shortest route to the access roads from your home. While traveling these routes a motorized snow vehicle must not reach speeds greater than 20 km/hr.

By-Law No. 108-00 (which includes the maps) is available for inspection at the Municipal Office located on the corner of Fifth Street and Lassie Road in Balmertown.
