**House Numbers**

A number of properties within the Municipality do not have a visible house number. A proper, visible address is important so that emergency personnel are able to locate the property in the event of an emergency.

Civic Address Numbers for Urban Lots are available free of charge from the Municipal Office on Fifth Street in Balmertown.

Civic Address Plates for Rural Lots are available for purchase from the Municipal Office for the following fees:

- Civic Address Plate: \$15.25 + Tax
- Civic Address Decals: \$0.75 + Tax
- Post: \$17.50 + Tax
- Hanging Hardware \$2.00 + Tax

Civic Address Plates for Rural Numbering System shall be:

- Installed or erected immediately adjacent to the driveway on the right hand side as seen from the street; and
- Installed not less than 1 meter and not more than 4 meters from the edge of the traveled portion of the street.

Where the Owner of a property fails to obtain, affix, erect or maintain the assigned civic address in accordance to this By-Law, the Municipality may enter upon the said property at any reasonable hour to affix, erect or maintain a civic address and may do so at the owner's expense.

**Garbage Collection Issues**

It has once again been brought to the Municipality's attention that many residents are neglecting to cover their garbage for curbside pickup.

As per section 5.1 of the Waste Management By-Law No. 1376-10, all garbage placed for collection must be in a container or covered with a blanket. A \$100.00 set fine may be issued for continued non-compliance.

It has also been brought to the Municipality's attention that bag tags are being cut in half resulting in half bag tags being used per bag. These will NOT be accepted at the landfill or collected from curbside.

Bags over 15 kg in weight and improperly sorted materials will also continue to be left curbside.
