Schedule “A” – Standing, Parking & Stopping Prohibited (North side of Discovery Road across from St. John’s Separate School)

NOTICE is hereby given of Council’s intention to adopt By-Law No. 80-2015 at its Regular Meeting of Council to be held on Monday, October 19th, 2015 at 6:00 p.m. in the Council Chambers, Municipal Office, Balmertown, for the purpose of amending Schedule “A” of the Parking By-Law.

Winter Parking Hours

The Municipal of Red Lake would like to remind residents that the winter calendar parking is in effect inclusive from November 1st until April 30th. During this time parking on Municipal Streets is prohibited between the hours of 12:00 a.m. and 7:00 a.m.

Vehicles may be ticketed or towed if in violation of the Parking By-Law. The owner will be responsible for the towing cost and storage fees.

Downtown Howey Street 2 Hour Parking

48 Hour Limit on Parking

As per Section 10.1 of By-Law No. 1046-08 no person shall park a vehicle on any highway for any consecutive period exceeding forty-eight (48) hours.



“Vehicle” includes a motor vehicle, motorized snow vehicle, **trailer**, traction engine, farm tractor, road-building machine and any vehicle drawn, propelled or driven by any kind of power.

Failure to comply with the 48 hour limit may result in a fine.

TAKE NOTICE that the Municipal Council of The Corporation of the Municipality of Red Lake will take into consideration the passing of and, if approved, will pass at its meeting to be held on the 19th day of October, 2015, at the hour of 6:00 p.m. in the evening, or at an adjourned meeting thereof, at the Council Chambers, Municipal Office, Balmertown, Ontario, a By-law relating to that portion of highway described as follows:

Part 1 Part of Mining Claim K1365; Township of Heyson; Municipality of Red Lake; District of Kenora, Being Part of PIN 42009-2218 (LT) ("the Highway") (portion of Farrington Road).

The lands are a portion of Highway unoccupied by buildings and are shown on the map as insert to this Notice.

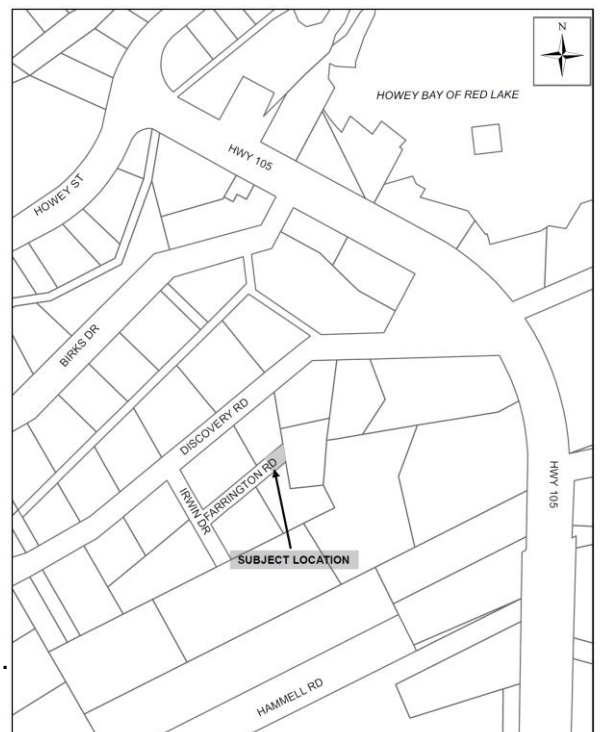
