NOTICE TO ALL RESIDENTS OF THE RED LAKE WATER DISTRIBUTION SYSTEM



Between October 25th and November 15th, 2015, the Municipality will be performing a scheduled shutdown of the Red Lake Water Tower.

These repairs are necessary to replace aging infrastructure and to guarantee the delivery of safe drinking water. The Red Lake Water Treatment Plant will be controlling the pressure of the water distribution system and fluctuations in water pressure may occur.
