Discharge of Firearms By-Law

NOTICE is hereby given of Council's intention to adopt a Discharge of Firearms By-Law at its Regular Meeting of Council to be held on Monday, November 16th, 2015 at 6:00 p.m. in the Council Chambers, Municipal Office, Balmertown.

Municipal Parking

Laneways

The By-Law Department would like to remind residents that parking is prohibited on any municipal highway where the roadway is 6 meters (20 feet) or less in width as per Section 6.10 of By-Law No. 1046-08. This includes several laneways throughout the Municipality as well as some streets.

Snow Removal

Parking is prohibited between the hours of 12:00 midnight to 7:00 a.m. daily from November 1st to April 30th inclusive of the following year during snow plowing and snow removal.

Please be advised that failure to comply with this By-Law may result in fines, costs for the removal of the unlawfully parked vehicle and/or possible damage to said vehicle.

Let's all do our part to allow our plows to clear our streets safely and efficiently.
