2016 Dog Licences

2016 Dog Licences are available at the Municipal Office in Balmertown.

The cost of a dog licence is as follows:

- i) For each spayed/neutered dog owned is \$15.00;
- ii) For each non-spayed/non-neutered dog owned is \$30.00;
- iii) For each additional dog owned in excess of two is \$100.00.



After January 31st, 2016, there will be a late penalty of \$10.00 per licence.
