**NOTICE OF A PUBLIC MEETING  
CONCERNING PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO  
THE OFFICIAL PLAN & ZONING BY-LAW  
AFFECTING THE MUNICIPALITY OF RED LAKE  
FILES: D09-16-01 & D14-16-01**

**TAKE NOTICE** that The Corporation of the Municipality of Red Lake (herein referred to as 'MORL') is proposing to amend the recently approved Official Plan and Zoning By-Law. The purpose of the amendments is to make revisions in accordance with comments provided by the province to ensure consistency with provincial policy; refine the rhetoric of policies and regulations; as well as correct formatting errors within the text and schedules (the nature of these amendments are commonly referred to as "Housekeeping Amendments").

**AND TAKE NOTICE** that the Planning Advisory Committee of the MORL will hold a public meeting on the date, and at the time and place shown below, in accordance with *Sections 21 & 34 of the Planning Act*, to consider recommending amendments to the Official Plan and Zoning By-Law. The Council of the MORL will consider a decision regarding the applications at their regular meeting following this public meeting or at a special meeting (which shall be advertised as per the Notice By-Law).

**ANY PERSON** may attend the public meeting and/or make written or verbal representation either in support of, or in opposition to the proposed Official Plan and Zoning By-Law Amendments.

**IF** you wish to be notified of the adoption of the proposed amendments to the Official Plan or the Zoning By-Law, you must make a written request to The Corporation of the Municipality of Red Lake at the address below.

**IF** a person or public body does not make oral submissions at a public meeting or make written submissions to the MORL before the proposed amendments to the Official Plan is adopted, or the amendments to the Zoning By-Law are approved, the person or public body is not entitled to appeal the decision of the Minister of Municipal Affairs and Housing to the Ontario Municipal Board.

**IF** a person or public body does not make oral submissions at a public meeting or make written submissions to the MORL before the proposed amendments to the Official Plan is adopted or the amendments to the Zoning By-Law are approved, the person or public body may not be added as a party to the hearing of an appeal before the Ontario Municipal Board unless, in the opinion of the Board, there are reasonable grounds to add the person or public body.
