EVACUATION PRIORITY REGISTRATION

As part of its annual review of the Municipality of Red Lake's Peacetime Emergency Plan, the Municipality is requesting residents complete an Evacuation Priority Registration Form. These forms will be placed in your mailboxes, within the next week. Forms may also be picked up at the Municipal Office in Balmertown or at the Red Lake Recreation Centre in Red Lake.

It is most important that in an emergency situation, municipal personnel are aware of residents who would require additional assistance.

WATER TREATMENT PLANTS UPDATE

The *Madsen WTP* is expected to be completed in April of this year, with the commissioning and turn over of the plant to the Municipality by the end of April. This date is approaching very quickly and after five years of planning and construction it is great to see it coming to an end.

The *Golden WTP* is on schedule and has a completion date of July 31st, 2004. The feeder line from Cochenour WTP to the Balmertown Reservoir will be back under construction this month with the interior and exterior work of the building continuing.
