## Balmertown Municipal Waste Disposal Site (Landfill)

As the Municipal Waste Disposal Site is nearing its approved capacity, it is important that residents utilize the Municipal curbside pick-up service for domestic waste. Curbside domestic waste is transported directly to the Ear Falls Landfill, as per a Shared Services Agreement between our two communities. However, when residents transport and deposit their domestic waste directly at the Municipal Waste Disposal Site, the waste remains at the landfill, which further impacts its remaining capacity.

The Municipality of Red Lake would like to thank residents for their efforts in prolonging the life span of our landfill.

## Reminder – Dogs at Beaches

The By-Law Department has been in receipt of complaints from residents that dogs are present at area beaches. As per Section 7.1 of the Dog By-Law No. 1877-14, **no person shall suffer, allow or permit any dog whether on a leash or not, to be in any place designated as a municipally controlled public beach or playground where posted.**

## Notice to Residents/Visitors – Municipal Road Upgrades/Paving Project

Work has commenced in the areas of the following streets/roads in the townsite of Red Lake: Pugsley, Edwards, Crosscut, Blende, Hasaga and Lavery Road.

Please be advised that due to culvert replacements, valve repairs, ditch line maintenance and upcoming paving reconstruction, you may experience brief disruptions in roadway traffic flow and resident driveway access. This project is scheduled to be completed in early September 2016.

## Door to Door Sales

Please be advised that the Municipality of Red Lake has a Business Licensing By-Law in effect to license, regulate and govern certain businesses, including door-to-door sales, in the Municipality of Red Lake. Door-to-Door Salespersons require a business license from the Municipality of Red Lake in order to solicit business.

Please note that you may ask a Door-to-Door Salesperson to present their business license to you to ensure that they have been approved by the Municipality.
