Residents are advised that as of November 1<sup>st</sup>, 2016, glass will no longer be collected separately and shall be included with regular household garbage.

## Reminder – Curbside Pick-up & The Municipal Waste Disposal Site (Landfill)

As the Municipal Waste Disposal Site is nearing its approved capacity, **it is important that residents utilize the Municipal curbside pick-up service** for domestic waste. Curbside domestic waste is transported directly to the Ear Falls Landfill, as per a Shared Service Agreement between our two communities. However, when residents transport and deposit their domestic waste directly at the Red Lake Municipal Waste Disposal Site, the waste remains at the landfill in Red Lake, which further impacts the landfill's remaining capacity.

The Municipality of Red Lake would like to thank residents for their efforts in prolonging the life span of our landfill.

## 2016 Municipal Capital Projects Update

### LED Street Lighting Project

Four hundred & sixty-two (462) of the five hundred & ninety-six (596) Municipal Street Lights have been converted to cobra-head LED's. The remaining conversions will take place over the coming weeks with the exception of McKenzie Island. The conversion of McKenzie Island Street will occur in January.

### Red Lake Paving Project

Paving of the areas of Edwards, Pugsley, Hasaga, Blende, Crosscut and Laverty commenced on Monday, September 12<sup>th</sup>. The Municipality anticipates the project to be completed by Friday, September 23<sup>rd</sup>, 2016.



### Cochenour Arena Roof Rehabilitation

The Cochenour Arena roof rehabilitation project is on schedule and barring any unforeseen circumstances, the Municipality anticipates the Arena being open for public use on or before October 7<sup>th</sup>, 2016.
