Garbage & Recycling Updates

Please be advised that as of November 1st, 2016, glass will no longer be collected separately at curbside on recycling collection days. Glass will only be accepted in mainstream garbage collection (garbage bags).

Please also note that Tim Horton's coffee cups are recyclable. Residents are reminded that styrofoam is not recyclable, which includes styrofoam egg cartons.

Residents are also reminded that recyclable material is not to be placed at curbside in bags, but must be placed in approved recycling containers only. Bags of recyclable material will not be picked up.
