Curbside Recycling Guidelines

Acceptable

Paper

Newspapers, magazines, paperback books, telephone books, computer paper, shredded paper (placed in a clear or blue translucent bag), brown paper bags, envelopes (with windows removed) & flyers

- Place papers in a recycling container or cardboard box.

Boxboard

Boxboard & juice/milk cartons, cereal boxes, tissue boxes, cracker boxes, shoe boxes, cardboard egg cartons, paper bags and Tim Horton's coffee cups.

- Remove liners or bags, flatten & place inside a recycling container or cardboard box.

Steel & Aluminum

Food & Beverage Cans

- Rinse and place loose inside cardboard box or recycling container.
- Metal lids can also be recycled.

Plastic

Plastic bottles, jugs and containers with the following numbers are accepted: 1-7 in a recycling symbol (turn upside down to find number on bottom of container).

- Rinse containers and place loose in cardboard box or recycling container. Lids are also recyclable.
- Does not include any styrofoam or plastic shopping bags.

Corrugated Cardboard

- Flatten & cut into 1 m x 1 m sections or less.
- Place in a recycling container or cardboard box.
- Container or box should not weigh more than 15 kgs.

Deposit Return Programs

- Liquor, beer & wine containers can be returned to the Beer Store for a refund.
- Plastic milk jugs can be returned to the grocery store for a refund.

NOT Acceptable

- ◆ Hard covers of a book
- ◆ Wax paper
- ◆ Coffee cups (except Tim Hortons)
- ◆ Textiles
- ◆ Clay flower pots*
- ◆ Light bulbs*
- ◆ Aerosol cans or paint cans*
- ◆ Metal toys or sheet metal*
- ◆ Cookie sheets, pots, or pans*
- ◆ Rubbermaid or Tupperware products*
- ◆ Glass
- ◆ Plastic planting flats and pots* (return reusable containers to garden centre)
- ◆ Styrofoam
- ◆ Aluminum foil, pie plates, etc.
- ◆ Scrap metal*
- ◆ Plastic bags, plastic packaging, saran wrap, etc.
- ◆ Plastic not containing recyclable symbol with #1-7
- ◆ Re-usable items*
- ◆ Toys or lawn furniture*
- ◆ Motor oil containers*
- ◆ E-Waste*

*These items will be accepted elsewhere at the Waste Disposal Site

NOTICE OF DECISION FOR ZONING BY-LAW AMENDMENT

BY-LAW NO. 74-2016

Planning Act, R.S.O. 1990, c.P.13, s. 34

NOTICE is hereby given, that the Council of The Corporation of the Municipality of Red Lake passed By-Law No. 74-2016 at their Regular Meeting held Monday, September 19th, 2016, thereby giving approval to a Zoning By-Law Amendment. Notice of the Application was given in reference to Planning File No. D14-16-02.

LOCATION OF PROPERTY: Adjacent to Highway 618, Fronting Snib Lake, Heyson Township, Mining Claim K1474. Refer to the location sketch.

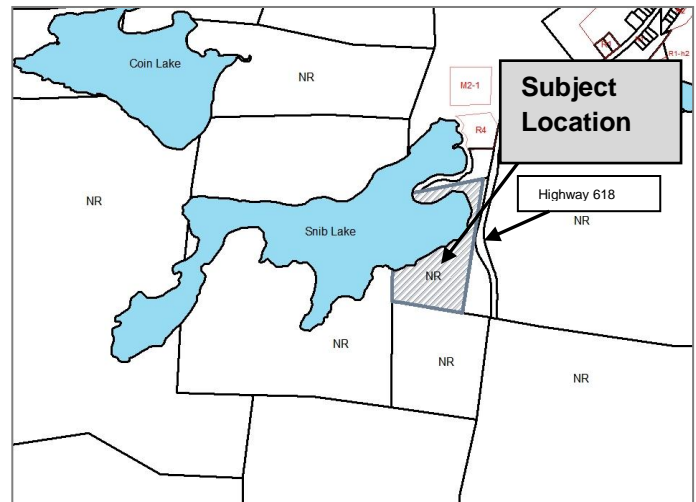
PURPOSE AND EFFECT OF BY-LAW: To change the regulated zoning to Recreational Residential (R5) Zone.

THE LAST DATE FOR FILING A NOTICE OF APPEAL is Monday, October 10th, 2016.

OTHER PLANNING APPLICATIONS RELEVANT TO THE SUBJECT LOCATION: An application for Consent may also be submitted to create three (3) lots.

Notices of appeal:

- i. must be filed with Christine Goulet, Clerk of The Corporation of the Municipality of Red Lake
- ii. must set out the reasons for the appeal, and
- iii. must be accompanied by the fee required by the Municipal Board of \$125.00



Only individuals, corporations and public bodies may appeal a by-law to the Ontario Municipal Board. A notice of appeal may not be filed by an unincorporated association or group. However, a notice of appeal may be filed in the name of an individual who is a member of the association or the group on its behalf.

No person or public body shall be added as a party to the hearing of appeal unless, before the by-law is passed, the person or public body made oral submissions at a public meeting or written submissions to the council or, in the opinion of the Ontario Municipal Board, there are reasonable grounds to add the person or public body as a party.
