A Community Improvement Plan (CIP) Project has been initiated by the Municipality of Red Lake. Stantec Consulting Ltd. has been retained to assist. The purpose of the CIP Project is to implement tools under the Ontario Planning Act, which will allow the Municipality to provide grants, loans and other financial incentives to private landowners in order to encourage private sector investment and the beautification and revitalization of lands within the municipality.
