No person shall feed nuisance animals on any public or private property within the boundaries of the Municipality of Red Lake. No person shall scatter or cause to scatter food, of any type, on any public or private property for any nuisance animal within the boundaries of the Municipality of Red Lake.

“**Nuisance Animals**” means any type of non-domesticated animal that may become a nuisance to the public which include, but not limited to, coyotes, bears, foxes, ravens, deer or crows.
