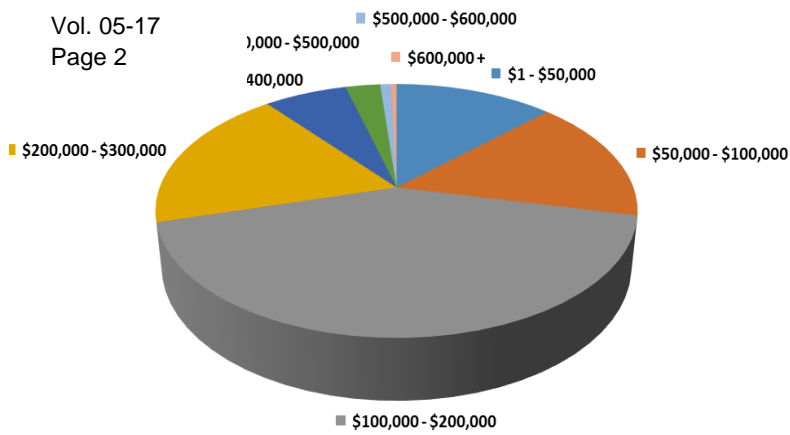

Canada Day Meeting

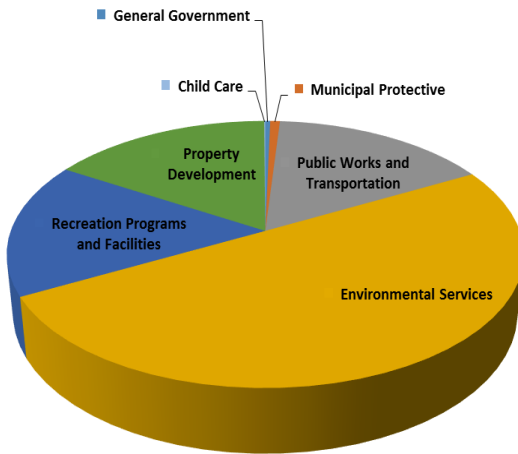

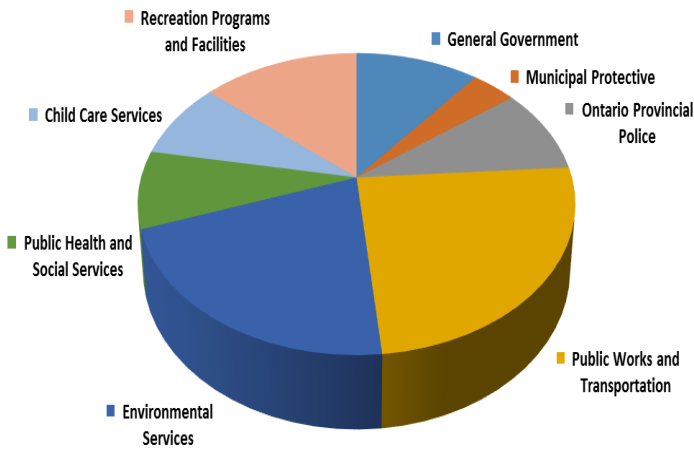

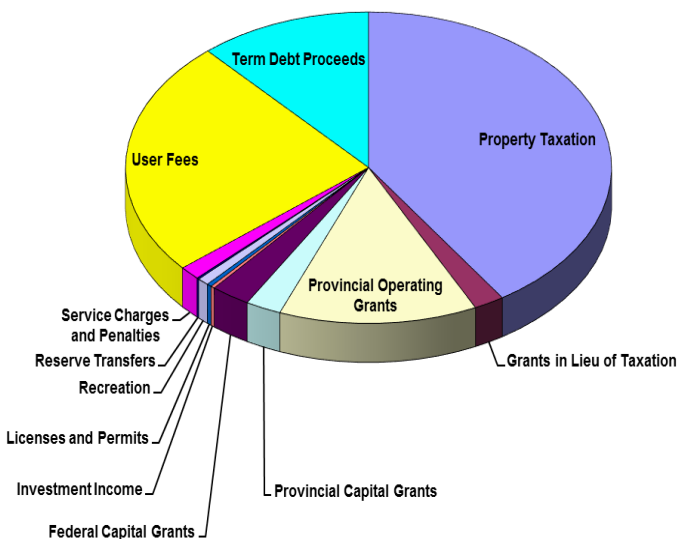

Community Improvement Plan

Municipality of Red Lake

Please be advised that the Council of the Municipality of Red Lake will be holding a Public Meeting pursuant to Section 28 of the Planning Act on Monday, June 19th, 2017 at 4:15 p.m., or as soon thereafter as possible, in the Municipal Council Chambers at 2 Fifth Street, Balmertown, Ontario.

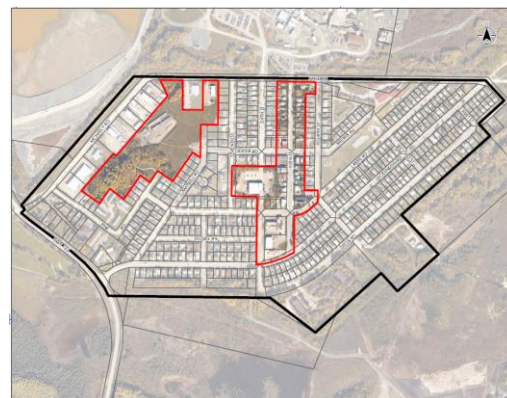
The purpose of the meeting is for Council to hear comments on the proposed Community Improvement Plan for the Municipality of Red Lake.

Purpose and Effect:

The purpose of the proposed Community Improvement Plan is to establish a program for municipal financial incentives to encourage the rehabilitation and improvement of private lands and buildings in the serviced townsites of Red Lake, Balmertown, Madsen, Cochenour, and McKenzie Island. The Community Improvement Plan policies would enable Council to offer the following financial incentives to private property owners:

- Design and Study Grant;
- Planning Application and Building Permit Fee Rebate;
- Façade, Signage and Property Improvement Grant;
- Brownfield Tax Assistant Grant;
- Building and Accessibility Improvement Grant;
- Parking Optimization Grant;
- Commercial and Rental Housing Conversion and Expansion Grant; and
- Tax Increment Equivalent Grant (TIEG).

These programs will apply to the 'Primary' Community Improvement Project Areas of Red Lake and Balmertown, as shown on the following maps:



These programs may also apply to the 'Secondary' Community Improvement Project Areas of Madsen, Cochenour, and McKenzie Island, as shown on Schedules A2 and A4 of the Red Lake Official Plan.

Representation:

Any person may attend the Public Meeting and make written and/or verbal representation. If a person or public body does not make an oral submission at the public meeting, or make written submissions to the Municipality of Red Lake regarding the Community Improvement Plan before the Plan is adopted, the person or public body is not entitled to appeal the decision of the Council of the Municipality of Red Lake to the Ontario Municipal Board and the person or public body may not be added as a party to the hearing or an appeal before the Ontario Municipal Board unless, in the opinion of the Board, there are reasonable grounds to do so.
