What you put down your drain/toilet can negatively impact the environment and be the cause of sewer blockages and back-ups. The following items **SHOULD NOT** go into the sewer system through your toilet and/or drain:

- Fats, oils & grease
- Food waste
- Rags
- J-cloths
- Paper towels
- ALL Feminine hygiene products
- Wipes & towelettes (includes face wipes, baby wipes, sanitary towelettes)
- Bandages
- Cotton balls/pads
- Diapers
- Kitty litter
- Dental floss
- Hair
- Pharmaceuticals
- Needles
- Paint

**The only product that should be flushed down the drain/toilet is toilet paper!!**
