Notice to Public – Municipal Landfill

As the Municipality prepares for final closure activities, the Landfill site will be open for **domestic waste and recycling drop off ONLY** for the week of **August 8th through to August 15th** as per regular scheduled hours (weather dependent). No steel, tires, construction debris, fridges, brush, household hazardous waste, etc. will be accepted during this time.

Trailers will not be permitted – only passenger vehicles will be permitted during this period.

Regular Landfill service will resume on August 16th as a transfer station.

The Municipality apologizes for any inconvenience this may cause.

Wildlife Encounters

The Municipality would like to remind residents and visitors NOT to feed wildlife ie: BEARS. This includes leaving any substances which could be reasonably expected to attract a wild animal or animals such as: food products/scraps, garbage, pet food and bird seed.

Proper garbage storage is key to minimizing wildlife encounters and with bear season upon us extra precautions are necessary to keep our families and properties safe.

Important Points:

1. Do not use municipal garbage cans to get rid of your fish guts or any other household garbage. This practice is an attractant.
2. Freeze any fish guts and put out on garbage day wrapped in newspaper to keep insulated and frozen until they are picked up.

The minimum set fines under By-Law No. 41-2015 *for the intentional feeding of wildlife or making available food attractants or other substances for the consumption of wildlife, is a **minimum of \$300.00 per offence. This includes illegal dumping of fish guts and other household waste.***

In case of emergency regarding dangerous wildlife encounters contact the OPP.

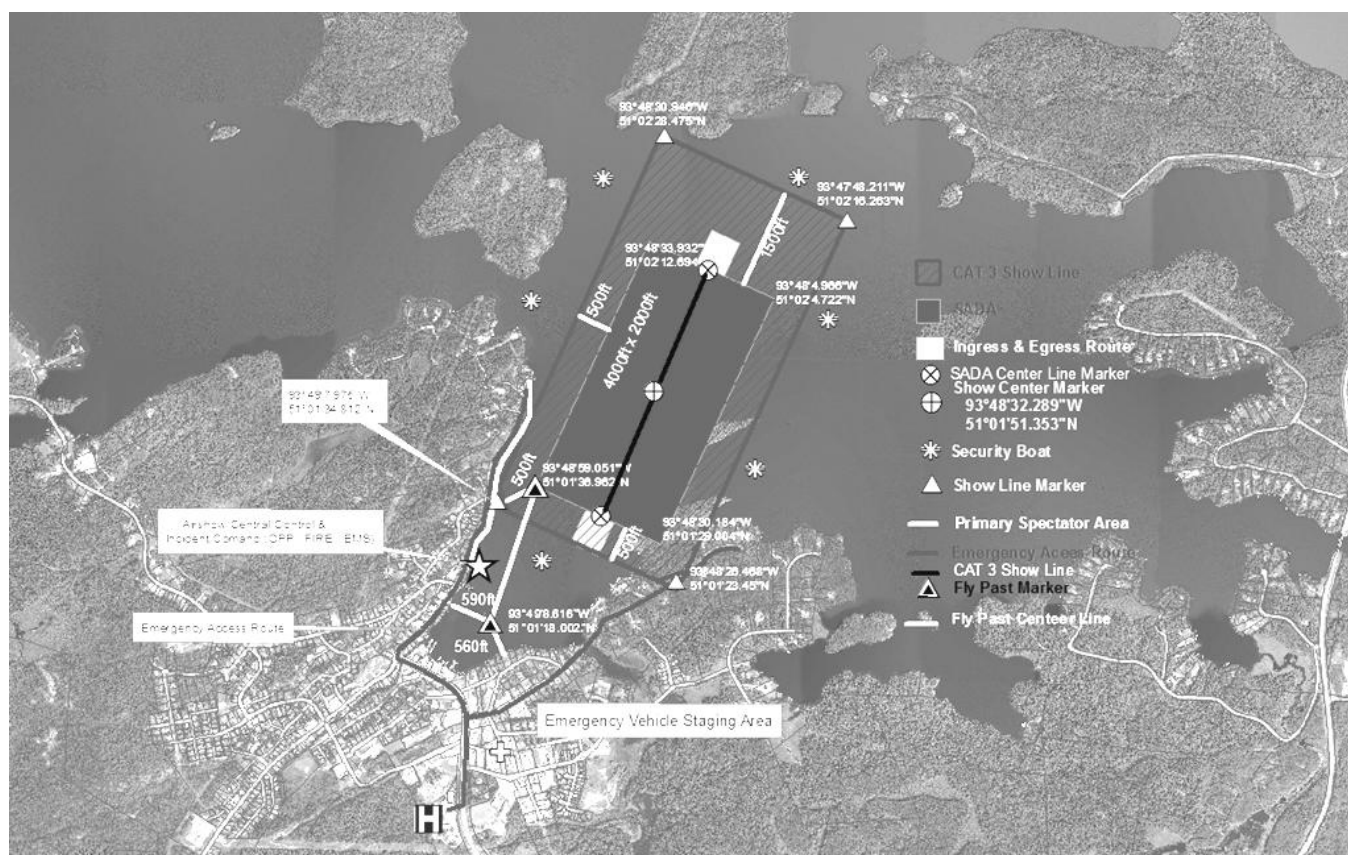
Attention Boaters – Norseman Festival
