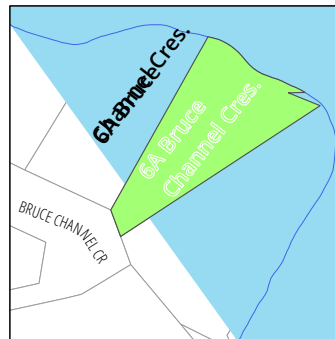

FOR A ZONING BY-LAW AMENDMENT, FILE NUMBER D14-17-03**  
Planning Act, R.S.O. 1990, c.P.13, s. 34 (13).

**TAKE NOTICE** that the Council of The Corporation of the Municipality of Red Lake has received a complete application for the Zoning By-Law Amendment described as follows:

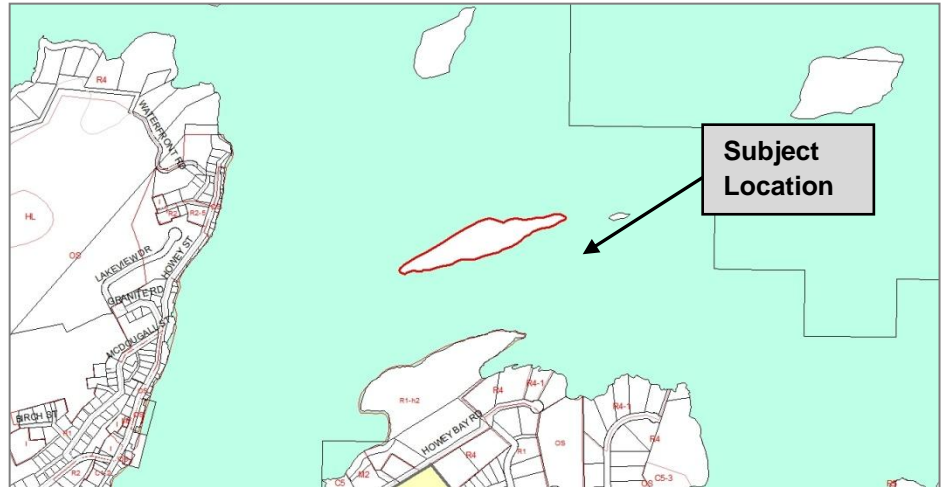
**LOCATION OF PROPERTY:** Cameron (Howey) Island. Refer to the location sketch below.

**PROPERTY DESCRIPTION:** The subject property is designated and zoned Natural Resources (NR). The property is currently undeveloped.

**PURPOSE AND EFFECT OF APPLICATION:** To change the regulated zoning to Recreational Residential (R5) Zone.

**OTHER PLANNING APPLICATIONS RELEVANT TO THE SUBJECT LOCATION:** None.

**ADDITIONAL INFORMATION** about the application is available for public inspection during regular office hours at the address shown below.



**TAKE NOTICE** that the application under the above file number will be heard by the Planning Advisory Committee (PAC) of The Corporation of the Municipality of Red Lake on the date, and at the time and place shown below. The Council of the Municipality of Red Lake will consider a decision regarding the application at their regular meeting following this public meeting or at a special meeting (which shall be advertised as per the Notice By-Law).

**PUBLIC MEETING:** You are entitled to attend this public meeting in person to express your views about the application. If you are aware of any person interested in or affected by the application who has not received a copy of this notice you are requested to inform that person of this meeting. If you wish to make written comments on the application, they may be forwarded to the Clerk of The Corporation of the Municipality of Red Lake at the address below.

**FAILURE TO MAKE ORAL OR WRITTEN SUBMISSION:** If a person or public body does not make oral submissions at a public meeting or make written submissions to the Council of The Corporation of the Municipality of Red Lake before the by-law is passed:

- the person or public body is not entitled to appeal the decision of the Council of The Corporation of the Municipality of Red Lake to the Ontario Municipal Board.
- the person or public body may not be added as a party to the hearing of an appeal before the Ontario Municipal Board unless, in the opinion of the Board, there are reasonable grounds to do so.

Appeal of a decision of the Municipality in respect of this amendment to the Zoning By-Law may be made by any person or public body not later than 20 days after notice of the decision is given.

**NOTICE OF DECISION:** If you wish to be notified of the decision of the Council of The Corporation of the Municipality of Red Lake in respect of the application for Zoning By-Law Amendment, you must make a written request to the Council of The Corporation of the Municipality of Red Lake at the address shown below.
