Glass bottle collection will be held at the Red Lake and Balmertown Public Works Yards, Monday, May 10th, 2004 to Saturday May 15th, 2004 from 8:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m. The \$0.10 return will again apply. A receipt will be issued at the Public Works Shops Building. Please present your receipt at the Municipal Office during regular office hours, Monday to Friday, 8:30 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. for payment.

A reminder to residents that pick-up is limited to a volume equal to 8ft. x 8ft. x 4ft. (approximately 10 cu. yds.) Materials should be separated into metals, wood (organics) and mixed waste. Tires, batteries, oil and hazardous goods will not be picked up. Refrigerators and freezers must be drained with certificate attached.

Material must be piled adjacent to the road fronting the resident's property, but must not protrude onto the road. Material should be bagged, boxed, or bundled where practical. Do not leave any containers that you want returned, as all material taken will be disposed of.

The Landfill will be open from 8:30 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. daily Monday through Saturday and during this time the Municipality will offer free disposal for residential properties only, (except tires, batteries, oil, and hazardous goods) should residents choose to dispose of their own goods.
