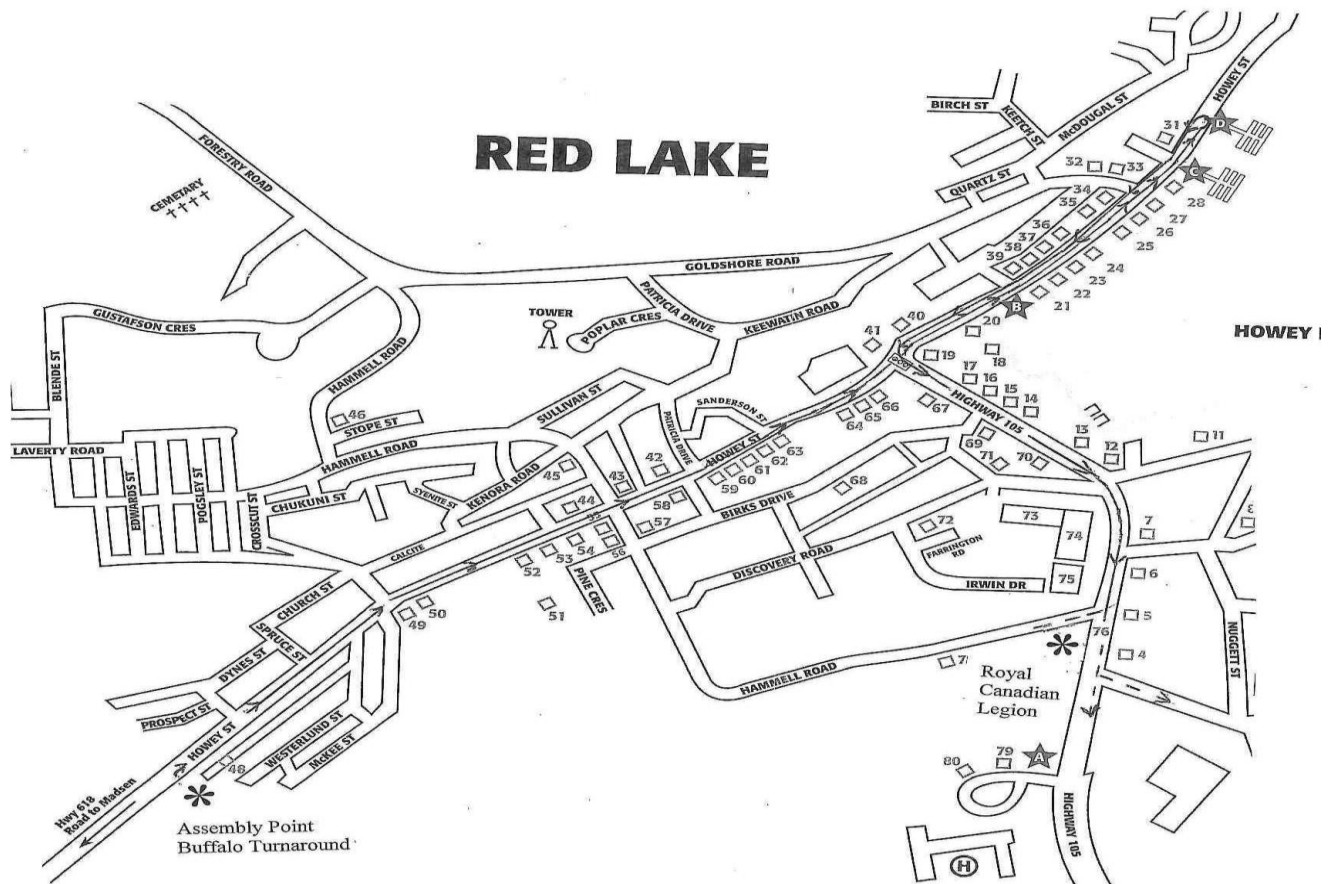

Santa Claus Parade – Friday, December 1st, 2017 at 6:00 p.m.



Floats can assemble at the Buffalo Turnaround between 5:30 p.m. and 5:40 p.m. for the parade to commence at 6:00 p.m. The parade will proceed east along Howey Street to the Government Dock Turnaround. After looping it will head back along Howey Street to the lights where it will turn left onto Highway 105 and continue to the Red Lake Royal Canadian Legion where the Santa Float will turn onto Hammell Road and park at the designated spot to allow Santa to disembark. The rest of the parade will continue to Young Street where the remaining floats can park or if they are returning to Balmertown or Cochenour can continue along Highway 105.
