Annual Permit:	\$40.00
4 Day Permit:	\$10.00
Incinerator Permit:	\$50.00
Level 3 Permit:	\$400.00
Inspection Fee	\$35.00

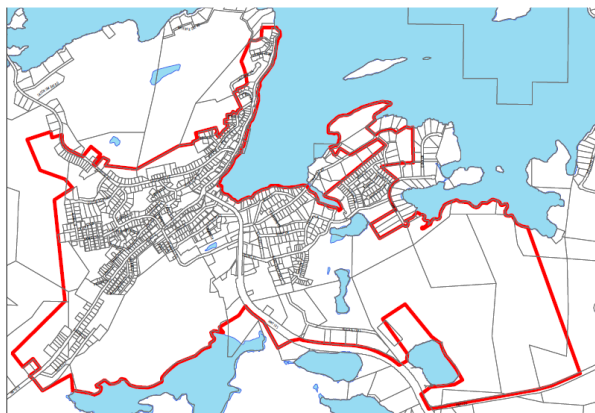


Notice of Public Meeting Proposed Amendment to Community Improvement Plan Municipality of Red Lake

Please be advised that the Council of the Municipality of Red Lake will be holding a Public Meeting pursuant to the Planning Act on Tuesday, May 22nd, 2018 at 4:30 p.m., or as soon thereafter as possible, in the Municipal Council Chambers at 2 Fifth Street, Balmertown, Ontario.

Purpose and Effect of Amendment: To change the boundaries of the Primary Community Improvement Project Areas to include the entire Townsites of Red Lake and Balmertown. There are proposed revisions to the Community Improvement Plan, including to Section 4 and to Appendix A to reflect the proposed revisions to the Primary Community Improvement Project Areas.

The proposed boundaries of the Primary Community Improvement Project Areas are shown on the following maps:



Representation:

Any person may attend the Public Meeting and make written and/or verbal representation. If a person or public body does not make an oral submission at the public meeting, or make written submissions to the Municipality of Red Lake regarding this proposed amendment before it is adopted, the person or public body is not entitled to appeal the decision of the Council of the Municipality of Red Lake to the Ontario Municipal Board and the person or public body may not be added as a party to the hearing or an appeal before the Ontario Municipal Board unless, in the opinion of the Board, there are reasonable grounds to do so.

FOR AN OFFICIAL PLAN AMENDMENT, FILE NUMBER D09-17-04
ZONING BY-LAW AMENDMENT, FILE NUMBER D14-17-04**

TAKE NOTICE that the Council of The Corporation of the Municipality of Red Lake is proposing to amend the Official Plan and Zoning By-Law. The amendments entail: housekeeping changes to revise errors and improve the clarity of the text and schedules; changes to the zoning of specific properties to revise errors and re-evaluate holding zones; and changes to the Official Plan designation of specific properties to allow existing zones to comply with their designations.

TAKE NOTICE that the proposed amendments under the above file numbers will be heard by the Planning Advisory Committee (PAC) of The Corporation of the Municipality of Red Lake on the date, and at the time and place shown below. The Council of the Municipality of Red Lake will consider a decision regarding the Official Plan Amendment and Zoning By-Law Amendment at their regular meeting following this public meeting or at a special meeting (which shall be advertised as per the Notice By-Law).

PUBLIC MEETING: You are entitled to attend this public meeting in person to express your views about the proposed amendments. If you are aware of any person interested in or affected by this proposal who has not received a copy of this notice you are requested to inform that person of this meeting. If you wish to make written comments, they may be forwarded to the Clerk of The Corporation of the Municipality of Red Lake at the address below.

FAILURE TO MAKE ORAL OR WRITTEN SUBMISSION: If a person or public body does not make oral submissions at a public meeting or make written submissions to the Council of The Corporation of the Municipality of Red Lake before the by-law is passed:

- a) the person or public body is not entitled to appeal the decision of the Council of The Corporation of the Municipality of Red Lake to the Ontario Municipal Board.
- b) the person or public body may not be added as a party to the hearing of an appeal before the Ontario Municipal Board unless, in the opinion of the Board, there are reasonable grounds to do so.

Appeal of a decision of the Council of The Corporation of the Municipality of Red Lake in respect of this proposed Amendment to the Official Plan and Zoning By-Law, may be made by any person or public body not later than 20 days after notice of the decision is given.

NOTICE OF DECISION: If you wish to be notified of the decision of the Council of The Corporation of the Municipality of Red Lake in respect of the proposed Official Plan Amendment and Zoning By-Law Amendment, you must make a written request to The Corporation of the Municipality of Red Lake at the address shown below.
