The Municipality of Red Lake is notifying residents that the Water Treatment Plant Annual Reports for the period of January 1st, 2017 to December 31st, 2017 for the following Water Treatment Plants are available for inspection at the Municipal Office in Balmertown and on the Municipal website www.redlake.ca:

- Balmertown, Cochenour, McKenzie Island Drinking Water System
- Madsen Drinking Water System
- Red Lake Drinking Water System

The Annual Reports are available, at no charge, to every person who requests a copy in accordance to the Safe Drinking Water Act, 2002.
