RED LAKE OPP DETACHMENT CONSTRUCTION UPDATE

The Red Lake Detachment construction project is scheduled for completion by Spring 2004. The project is staged into four different phases. The first three phases have been completed, and Phase Four is presently underway.

Phase Four:

- Phase four construction started the end of March 2004 and will involve the renovation of the upper floor of the existing Detachment building.
- The new renovations include male and female locker rooms, additional interview rooms, installation of new permanent back-up generator, enhanced security renovations to court office and new entrance to courtroom.
- Scheduled for completion end of May 2004.

The new facility will meet and/or exceed the current Adequacy and Effectiveness Standards for Police Services in Ontario.

GOLDEN/MADSEN WARD WATER TREATMENT PLANTS (WTP)

The completion dates for the WTP(s) have changed due to delays with the construction.

The Madsen WTP completion date is set for June 15, 2004.

The Golden WTP completion date is set for September 30, 2004.
