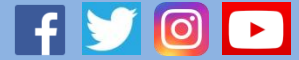

## Update on a number of Municipal Projects

### Forestry Road

- ✓ Road rehabilitation and crack sealing has been completed.

### Government Docks

- ✓ Concrete upgrades to walkway and sidewalks has been completed.

### Goldshore Road

- ✓ New storm drains, paving, sidewalk and curbs and gutters.
- Landscaping to be completed in early September.

### Waterfront Road

- ✓ Road rehabilitation and paving completed.
- Landscaping to be completed in early September.

### Municipal Transfer Station

- ✓ Completion of cell 1 expansion.
- ✓ Footings poured for quick drop off facility for residential waste.
- ✓ Grade work for road has been completed.
- ✓ New scrap steel trailer completed.
- Construction continues for the quick drop off facility for residential waste.
- Paving of road will commence in September.
- Construction of new scale house has started.
- Storage facilities for tires, fridges, etc. are built and ready for delivery.
- Hydro and electricity will be available to the site in the late fall.

### McKenzie Island Playground Equipment

- ✓ New playground equipment installed.

### Dickenson Road & Eighth Street Intersection

- Storm drain upgrades and road rehabilitation has started.

### Events Centre

- ✓ RFP's are being accepted for Class 'A' tendered engineered drawings for an Events Centre. This will allow for the proposed project to be shovel ready.

### Arena

- ✓ Completion of necessary plant repairs and heating system upgrades.
