The application shall be in writing and shall be filed in person, or by mail, email or fax by the applicant or his/her agent. Proof of identity and residence as prescribed in O. Reg. 304/13 will be required of the applicant. If the applicant does not appear in person, a certified copy showing proof of ID and proof of residence/occupancy is required.

Qualifications of Electors

A person is entitled to vote in a municipal election if her or she on voting day,

- Resides in the local municipality, or is the owner or tenant of land in the municipality, or the spouse of such owner or tenant; and
- Is a Canadian citizen, and
- Is at least 18 years old, and
- Is not prohibited from voting by law.

Red Lake Fire Rescue's Volunteer Fire Fighters had a very successful week at the FireFit Nationals & World Championships this past weekend in Calgary. All three members of the team posted new personal bests on the course. **Alex Soley** ran a 1:40; **Jason Tsolas** ran a 2:50; and **Heather Willis** won the top Female Volunteer and ran a 3:10. The team also set a new personal best on the relay of 1:36.



The FireFit Championships is a competition based on fire fighting tasks commonly performed in emergency situations. Participants race through the grueling course while wearing complete firefighting gear under air, simulating the conditions that would be experienced in a fire fighting situation. This was the world championships with competitors representing Canada, USA, the UK and Germany.
