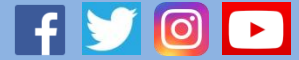

Speed Limit within the Municipality – 40 km/hr

Residents are reminded that the speed limit on ALL municipal roads is 40 km/hr. Highway 105, 125 and 618 are exempt as these roads are provincially regulated (watch for posted speed limit signs on these non-municipal roads).

Pursuant to By-Law No. 1235-09, "No person shall drive a motor vehicle at a greater rate than forty (40) kilometers per hour on any highway under the jurisdiction of the Municipality of Red Lake.

No Parking – Snow Removal November 1st until April 30th

By-Law No. 81-2016 states that effective November 1st until April 30th, there is to be no parking on any street between the hours of 12:00 midnight and 7:00 a.m. within the Municipality of Red Lake (Cochonour Townsite is exempt from this By-Law).

Any vehicle, which includes campers, trailers and boats in violation of this By-Law will be ticketed or towed at the owner's expense.

BE AWARE! Fire can happen *anywhere*.

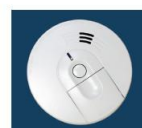


LOOK for potential fire hazards around your home.

Take action to **prevent** fire from starting.



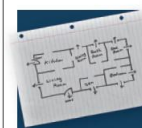
GET OUT & STAY OUT!



LISTEN for the smoke alarm in an emergency.

Make sure everyone knows the sound of the smoke alarms and can hear them in an emergency.

There is **no time to spare** in a fire. Early detection gives you the extra seconds you need to get out safely.



LEARN two ways out of every room in your home.

Practice an escape plan with everyone in your home before a fire starts so you and your family can get out quickly.



When the smoke alarms sound in an emergency, get out **immediately** and call 9-1-1 from outside. **Never re-enter a burning building.**
