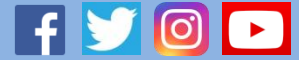

## 4<sup>th</sup> Annual Art Show

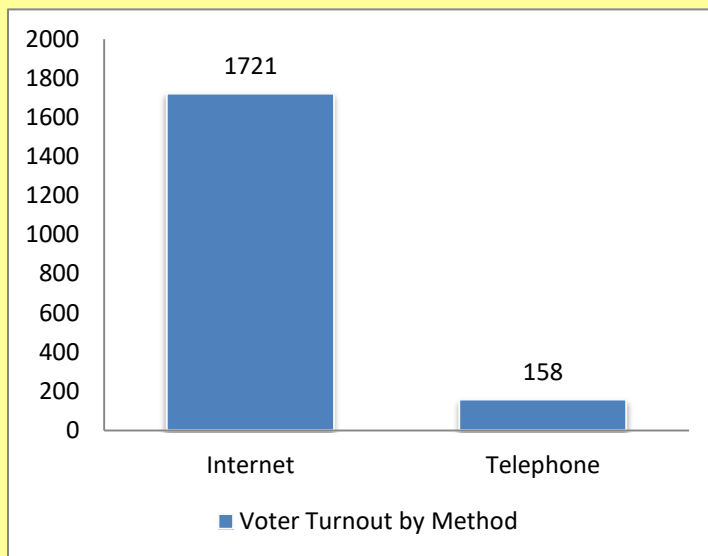
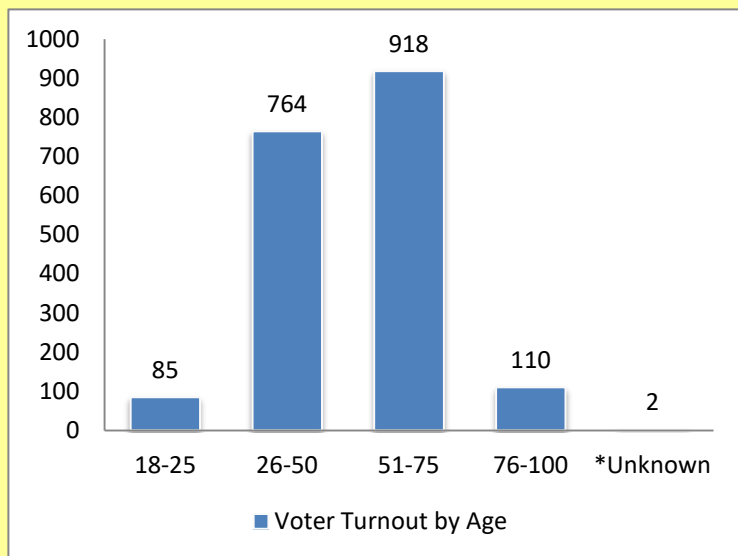

# 2018 Municipal Election Voter Statistics

- 2018 Voter turnout – **66.4%** for Red Lake (1879 voted out of 2827 eligible voters). 37.6% was the average turnout across Ontario (431 out of 444 reporting municipalities).
- Voters voted from within Canada, United States, Dominican Republic, Switzerland and the Netherlands.
- Survey Results - We received 298 responses regarding the satisfaction of voters with the on-line voting process. Out of the 298 responses 96% were satisfied with on-line voting, while 4% were not.

## Clarification – No Parking Notice

It has come to our attention that our previous notice within Newsletter Volume 15-18 may have been unclear.

**Snow Removal:** Please be advised that for snow removal purposes, parking is not permitted on any street between the hours of 12:00 midnight and 7:00 a.m. This By-Law is in effect for the winter snow season from November 1<sup>st</sup> until April 30<sup>th</sup>. (Cochenour townsite is exempt from this By-Law).

**All townsites:** There is to be no parking of campers, trailers, snowmachines, boats, etc. on any street and/or any laneway (this By-Law affects all townsites within the Municipality)
