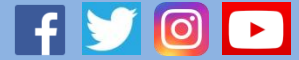

All donations are in support of the Red Lake Emergency Shelter.

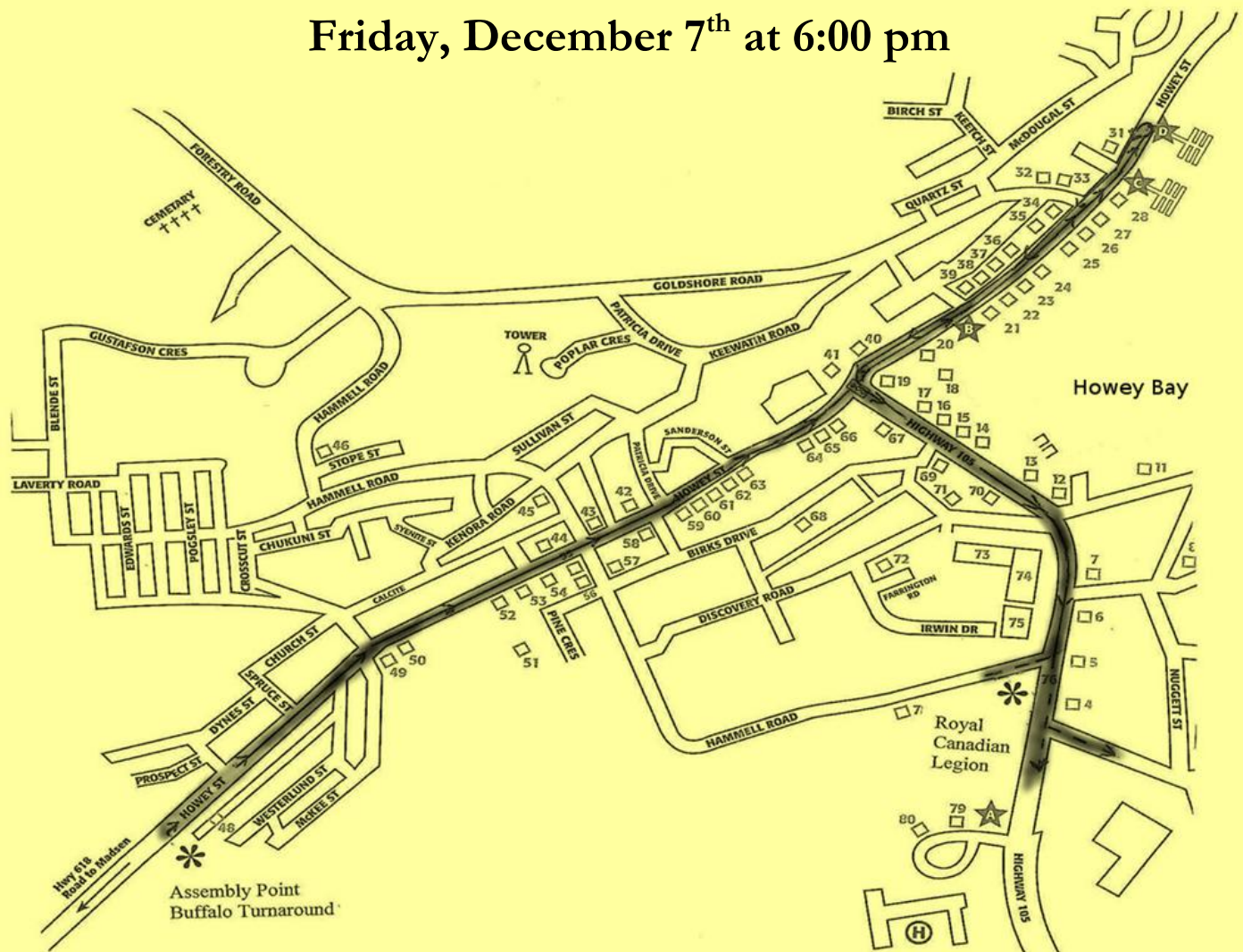
Invitation to Public Inaugural Meeting of Council

The newly elected Council will complete their Declaration of Office and meet with the public.

2018 Santa Claus Parade

Friday, December 7th at 6:00 pm



If you wish to enter a float in the parade contact 727-3275 before December 5th at 4:00 p.m.

All floats are to assemble at the **Buffalo Turnaround between 5:30 PM and 5:40 PM for the parade to commence at 6:00 PM.** The parade will proceed east along Howey Street to the Government Dock Turnaround. After looping it will head back along Howey Street to the lights where it will turn left on to Highway 105 and continue to the Red Lake Royal Canadian Legion where the Santa Float will turn on to Hammell Road and park at the designated spot to allow Santa to disembark into the Legion. **The rest of the parade will continue to Young Street where floats that remain can park or if they are returning to Balmertown or Cochenour can continue along Highway 105**

Float rules

- For safety concerns nothing should be thrown from the float. If you wish to give out candy have walkers hand it to the children so they do not run out into the street.
- Our insurance policy does not allow saddle animals or animal drawn vehicles i.e. no horses.
- Please make sure your electrical setup for lights is safe!
- Make sure riders on floats are secure; children must be supervised by a responsible person.
- Do not climb on or off float while it is in motion.
- All float drivers must have a valid driver's license for the type of vehicle used.

**Come visit with Santa at the Legion immediately following the parade. There will be hot dogs, hot chocolate and treats available.
