Notice – Procedural By-Law

NOTICE is hereby given of Council’s intention to amend its Procedural By-Law at its Regular Meeting of Council to be held on Monday, December 17th, 2018 at 6:00 p.m. in the Council Chambers, Municipal Office.

A copy of the proposed By-Law is available for inspection in the Office of the Clerk, Monday to Friday, between the hours of 8:30 a.m. and 4:30 p.m. or on the municipal website at www.redlake.ca.

Waste and Recycling Pickup Schedule – Holiday changes

Changes to the waste and recycling pick up schedule during the holidays are as follows:

Tuesday, December 25th will now be picked up on **Monday, December 24th**.

Tuesday, January 1st will now be picked up on **Monday, December 31st**.

Christmas Tree Curbside Collection – Thursday, January 10th, 2019

Trees must be cut in half and placed on the curbside the evening before or the day of collection. Trees must be easily accessible and not have been plowed into the snow bank. Trees must NOT be wrapped in a plastic bag. Trees will not be collected unless all the above conditions are met.

Trees can also be dropped off at the Municipal Transfer Station for FREE during normal operating hours.

Recycling Reminders

With Christmas season upon us we would like to remind residents of the recycling restrictions as it relates to holiday packaging. Below is a list of some of the items that are and are not recyclable:

The following items **ARE NOT** recyclable:



- Wrapping paper
- Gift bags
- Tissue paper
- Styrofoam packing materials
- Plastic bags
- Plastic attached to cardboard
- Plastic wrap
- Foil and foil containers
- Cords and wires
- Meat trays and containers
- Plastic cutlery
- Frozen juice containers

The following items **ARE** recyclable:



- Cardboard boxes*
- Wrapping paper rolls
- Toilet paper and paper towel rolls
- Milk cartons**
- Plastic juice cartons**
- Food and beverage cans**
- Juice boxes
- Construction and art paper (no crayon wax or glue)
- Magazines/flyers/catalogues

*Cardboard must be crushed flat and any tape removed

**All items are to be rinsed clean

Remove lids to allow air circulation through the container

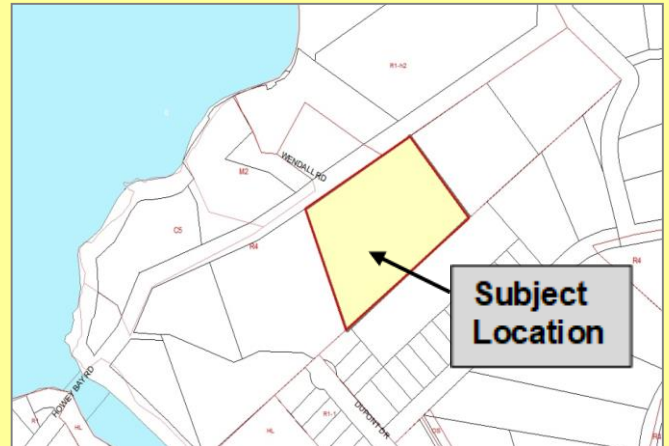
**NOTICE OF APPLICATION AND PUBLIC MEETING
FOR A TEMPORARY USE PROVISION, FILE NUMBER D14-18-04**
Planning Act, R.S.O. 1990, c.P.13, s. 39.

TAKE NOTICE that the Council of The Corporation of the Municipality of Red Lake has received a complete application for a Temporary Use Provision described as follows:

LOCATION OF PROPERTY: 79 Howey Bay Road. Refer to the location sketch below.

PROPERTY DESCRIPTION: The subject property is designated Rural Residential in the Official Plan and zoned Rural Residential (R4). There is currently a single family dwelling and detached garage on the property. In January 2018 a temporary use provision was approved to change the permitted use to allow for home based business activities to include small engine and marine repair, and welding, for one year.

PURPOSE AND EFFECT OF THE APPLICATIONS: The applicant is requesting to extend the term of the previously approved temporary use provision. If approved, the permitted use would be temporary changed to allow for home based business activities to include small engine and marine repair, and welding, for an additional three years.



OTHER PLANNING APPLICATIONS RELEVANT TO THE SUBJECT LOCATION: An Application for Temporary Use Provision, File D14-17-01 was approved on January 16, 2018. No other applications have been received as of the date of this notice.

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION about the application is available for public inspection during regular office hours at the address shown below.

TAKE NOTICE that the Temporary Use Provision application under the above file number will be heard by the Planning Advisory Committee (PAC) of The Corporation of the Municipality of Red Lake on the date, and at the time and place shown below. The Council of the Municipality of Red Lake will consider a decision regarding the application at their regular meeting following this public meeting or at a special meeting (which shall be advertised as per the Notice By-Law).

PUBLIC MEETING: You are entitled to attend this public meeting in person to express your views about the application. If you are aware of any person interested in or affected by the application who has not received a copy of this notice you are requested to inform that person of this meeting. If you wish to make written comments on the application, they may be forwarded to the Clerk of The Corporation of the Municipality of Red Lake at the address below.

FAILURE TO MAKE ORAL OR WRITTEN SUBMISSION: If a person or public body does not make oral submissions at a public meeting or make written submissions to the Council of The Corporation of the Municipality of Red Lake before the by-law is passed:

- a) the person or public body is not entitled to appeal the decision of the Council of The Corporation of the Municipality of Red Lake to the Ontario Municipal Board.
- b) the person or public body may not be added as a party to the hearing of an appeal before the Ontario Municipal Board unless, in the opinion of the Board, there are reasonable grounds to do so.

Appeal of a decision of the Municipality in respect of the Temporary Use Provision may be made by any person or public body not later than 20 days after notice of the decision is given.

NOTICE OF DECISION: If you wish to be notified of the decision of the Council of The Corporation of the Municipality of Red Lake in respect of the application for a Temporary Use Provision, you must make a written request to the Council of The Corporation of the Municipality of Red Lake at the address shown below.
