## **SPRING CLEAN-UP**

Spring clean-up weeks are over. This year's collection time required only one week longer than planned. As we refine our system of collection in the coming years, and the amounts of refuse dwindle, we should hit our targets for collection efficiency. This year upwards of 75 tandem loads of refuse were removed to the Waste Disposal Site.

The Operations Staff would like to thank the Residents for registering for pick-up and for the orderly stacking of the items to be collected. It made the job much more efficient and less time consuming.

**NUISANCE BEARS**

The Municipality of Red Lake is urging residents to be aware and to work together to avoid attracting nuisance bears.

Nuisance bears don't always have good quality food available. Until berries and other natural foods are available, nuisance animals will eat whatever they can get, including garbage, pet food, birdseed, or compost. They will also return to food sources they remember from last year.

To reduce the chances of attracting nuisance bears, the Municipality advises residents to:

- Deposit waste in containers only on the day of collection.
- Wash garbage containers frequently and use disinfectant to cut odors.
- Keep barbecues and picnic tables clean.
- Remove all birdfeeders.
- Keep pet food inside the house.
