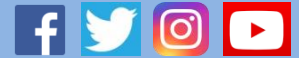

TAKE NOTICE that the Council of The Corporation of the Municipality of Red Lake has received a complete application for the Consent described as follows:

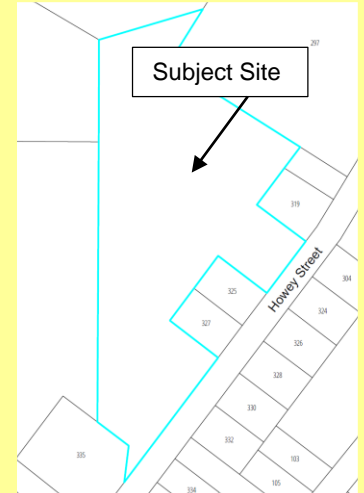
LOCATION OF PROPERTY: Property located in the Townsite of Red Lake, refer to the location sketch below.

PURPOSE AND EFFECT OF APPLICATION: To receive Planning Act Consent to sever property, having the effect of creating one (1) new lot and retaining one (1).

NOTICE OF DECISION: If you wish to be notified of the decision of the Committee of Adjustment in respect of the proposed consent, you must make a written request to the Committee of Adjustment at the address shown below.
