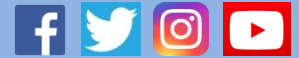

## Check your Water Usage

You can check your water usage and find out if you have any leaks. Visit our website at [www.redlake.ca](http://www.redlake.ca).

You will need to enter your water meter number (10 digit number listed on your invoice below 'WM') and your address EXACTLY as shown on your invoice (include all CAPS, lower case, spaces and abbreviations).

If your status shows a leak – check all your taps and toilets for running water and make the necessary repairs to avoid additional water usage charges.

## Bill Payment Options

Municipal invoices can be paid through on-line banking at the following banks: BMO Bank of Montreal, CIBC, Copperfin Credit Union, Royal Bank and Scotiabank.

As always, you can still pay your Municipal invoices in-person at the Municipal Office by cash, cheque, Debit, VISA and Mastercard.

## Reminder: 2019 Dog Licences

2019 dog tags are available at the Municipal Office.

The cost of a dog licence is as follows:

- **spayed/neutered - \$15.00.**
- **non-spayed/non-neutered - \$30.00.**
- Each dog in **excess of two** is **\$100.00.**

After Jan. 31<sup>st</sup>, 2019 - late penalty **\$10.00**

**PROPERTY DESCRIPTION:** The subject properties are designated Townsite Residential, and zoned Rural Residential (R4).

**PURPOSE AND EFFECT OF APPLICATION:** To receive Planning Act Consent to sever property, having the effect of creating one (1) new lot and retaining two (2).

**FAILURE TO MAKE WRITTEN SUBMISSION:** If a person or public body that files an appeal of a decision of the Committee of Adjustment in respect of the proposed consent does not make written submissions to the Committee of Adjustment before it gives or refuses to give a provisional consent, the Ontario Municipal Board may dismiss the appeal.

**NOTICE OF DECISION:** If you wish to be notified of the decision of the Committee of Adjustment in respect of the proposed consent, you must make a written request to the Committee of Adjustment at the address shown below.
