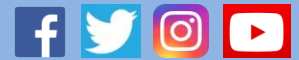

Fire Permit Reminder

Fire permits are required for burning within municipal boundaries during the annual fire season (April 1st – October 31st). The conditions of By-Law 38-2018 shall be complied with and fire permits shall be purchased. There is to be NO DAY BURNING during the fire season.

In accordance with the User Fees and Charges By-Law the fees for fire permits are as follows: Annual Permit - \$40/season; 4 Day Permit - \$10/permit; Incinerator Permit - \$50/season; Level 3 Permit - \$400/season; Inspection Fee - \$35.

TAKE NOTICE that the Council of The Corporation of the Municipality of Red Lake has received a complete application from the Kenora District Services Board (KDSB) for the Consent described as follows:

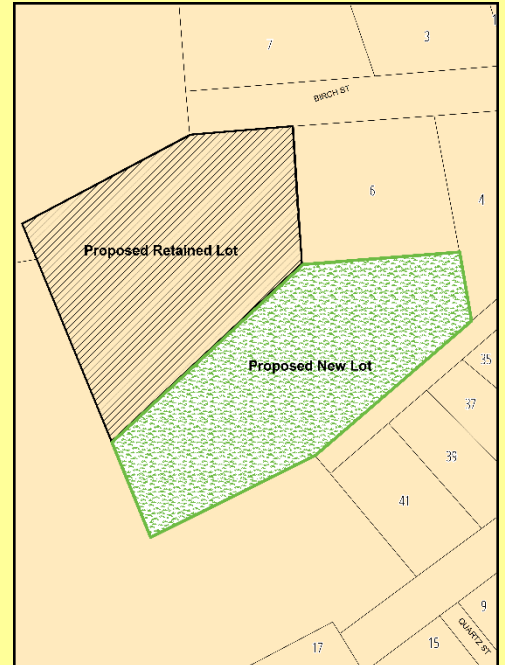
LOCATION OF PROPERTY: #10 Birch Street, Red Lake, refer to the location sketch.

PROPERTY DESCRIPTION: The subject property is designated Townsite Residential and zoned Institutional.

PURPOSE AND EFFECT OF APPLICATION: To receive Planning Act Consent to sever property, having the effect of creating one (1) new lot and retaining one (1) lot. The application also seeks to establish an easement over the retained lot to provide access to the new lot.

OTHER PLANNING APPLICATIONS RELEVANT TO THE SUBJECT LOCATION: Zoning By-Law Amendment (File D14-19-01) to change a portion of the regulated zoning to Institutional with site specific provisions (I-2) and the other portion to Townsite Residential Density 2 with site specific provisions to permit a 10 unit multi-residential building together with accessory office space (R2-9).

If you wish to make written comments on this application, they may be forwarded to the Secretary of the committee at the address below.

FAILURE TO MAKE WRITTEN SUBMISSION: If a person or public body that files an appeal of a decision of the Committee of Adjustment in respect of the proposed consent does not make written submissions to the Committee of Adjustment before it gives or refuses to give a provisional consent, the Local Planning Appeal Tribunal may dismiss the appeal.

NOTICE OF DECISION: If you wish to be notified of the decision of the Committee of Adjustment in respect of the proposed consent, you must make a written request to the Committee of Adjustment at the address shown below.
