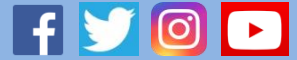

The Red Lake Airport runway will be undergoing upgrades over a number of weeks. In order to complete these upgrades it is necessary to close the runway temporarily during the following times:

Please note, it may be necessary for a 4th closure to account for any construction delays and extra time that may be required to ensure the airport is back into an operational state. If additional closure is required, the above schedule will continue until completion.

Red Lake Margaret Cochenour Memorial Hospital – Emergency Patient Transfers during Red Lake Airport Closure

Be advised that land ambulance transfers may be used more frequently between the Red Lake Hospital and other hospitals during the temporary closure of the airport.

Transfer by ORNGE helicopter will be the preferred choice for patients going to Thunder Bay or Winnipeg. However, if transfer by helicopter is not an option due to weather or availability, then the transfer will include land ambulance to Dryden airport and air transfer by plane to Thunder Bay or Winnipeg. Transfers to hospitals in Dryden, Kenora and Sioux Lookout will be by helicopter when possible or more likely, by land ambulance.

Feeding of Wildlife



Bear season is now upon us and residents are reminded to ensure all food products/scraps, garbage, pet food and bird seed is properly stored to minimize wildlife encounters.

Do not use municipal garbage cans to get rid of fish guts or any other household garbage as it can attract animals to these areas.

There is a minimum fine of \$300 under By-Law No. 41-2015 for intentionally feeding wildlife, which includes illegal dumping of fish guts and household waste.

In case of emergency regarding dangerous wildlife encounters call 911 and non-emergency bear encounters call the Bear Wise reporting line at 1-866-514-2327.
