

Illegal Dumping

It has been brought to the Municipality's attention that there has been debris being deposited on municipal property and privately owned lands throughout the Municipality of Red Lake.

Please note, there is a maximum fine of \$5,000.00 for individuals found to be non-compliant with By-Law No. 68-2016.

The following items are accepted at the Transfer Station FREE of charge:

- Clean wood (non-painted, stained, treated or glued);
- Brush;
- residential tires;
- E-waste; and
- Scrap metal.

Flushing of the Municipality Hydrants for Maintenance of the Drinking Water Systems

To all Residents and Businesses within the Municipality of Red Lake (Red Lake, Cochenour, Balmertown, McKenzie Island and Madsen)

FROM: Northern Waterworks Inc.

DATES: August 12th to September 30th, 2019

TIMES: Between the hours of 8:00 am and 6:00 pm

Commencing August 12, 2019 (except weekends) Northern Waterworks will be flushing hydrants at various locations within the Red Lake area.

Please note the following may occur:

1. Discolouration of the drinking water. If this happens run tap water until the water clears.
2. It is recommended that you shut off the water to your hot water tank during the above-mentioned periods to prevent water hammer (sudden water pressure in pipes) in older tanks.
