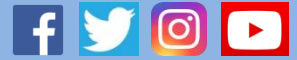

Where can I hunt?

Hunting season is now upon us and for the safety of everyone it is important to know where you can and cannot discharge a firearm within the Municipal boundaries.

By-Law No. 37-2016 sets out the regulations for discharging firearms within Municipal Boundaries and includes maps that show where discharging of firearms is prohibited. The complete By-Law can be found on the municipal website at www.redlake.ca. Maps can also be found on the municipal website and are available for pick up at the Municipal Office in Balmertown.

Feeding of Wildlife

Help keep wildlife away from your property:

- DO NOT feed any wildlife – either intentionally or unintentionally. Making food available can attract wildlife to your property, can make them less fearful of humans, and make them accustomed to food provided by humans.
- Properly store garbage containers. Put garbage at curbside the morning of collection and not the night before.

The minimum set fine under By-Law No. 41-2015 for the *intentional feeding of wildlife or making available food attractants or other substances for the consumption of wildlife*, is a minimum of \$300.00 per offence.

Lot & House Numbering

Do you have a number on your house or on your rural lot to ensure your house and/or property can be easily located?

If your house or rural lot does not have a number, emergency response units may not be able to locate your address to respond quickly and efficiently.

House numbers are required for all rural and urban lots within the Municipality of Red Lake. Please refer to the House and Lot Numbering By-Law No. 521-04 which is available on our website at www.redlake.ca under 'By-Laws & Resolutions'.

House numbers are available for FREE (limited supply) at the Municipal Office in Balmertown.

Rural lot numbers and posts can be purchased at the Municipal Office in Balmertown for a minimal fee (details as follows):

Number Plate	\$15.50 + HST	Posts	\$17.50 + HST
Reflective Numbers	\$0.75 each + HST	Hardware	\$2.00 + HST
