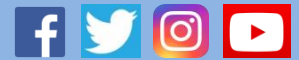

Reminder – Winter Snow Removal

All snow removed from your driveway is to remain on your property and is not to be deposited on neighbouring properties, roadways, sidewalks.

This includes pushing snow across roadways. This action can be hazardous to vehicular traffic as snow will pack down on the road making it more difficult for plows to peel the roads. As well it can result in large snow banks encroaching on to the roadway which makes it difficult for plow operators to remove.

Large piles of snow on roadways and sidewalks pose a safety concern as they can obstruct normal visibility of vehicular and pedestrian traffic.

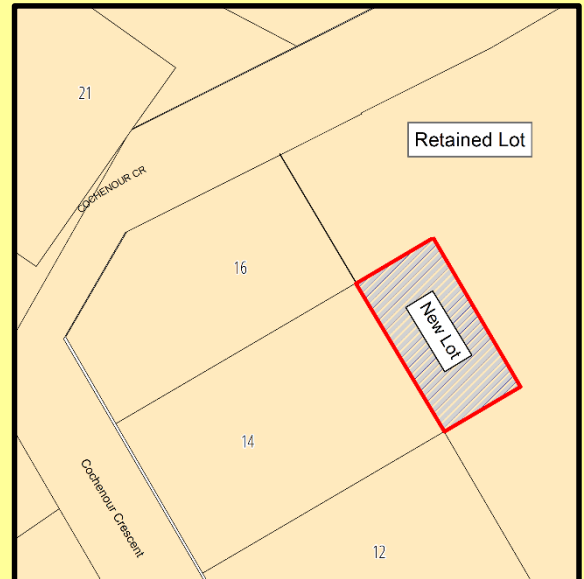

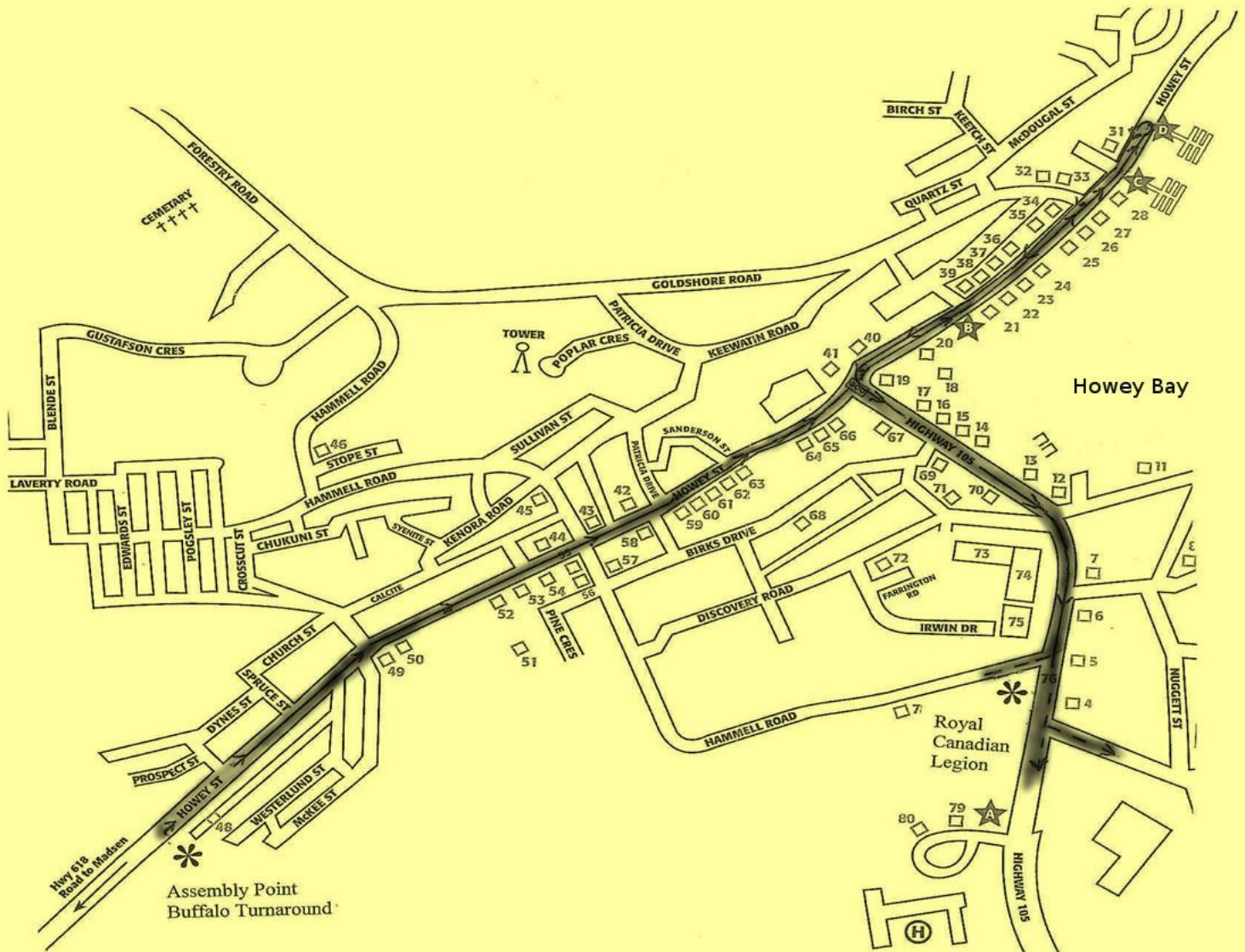
