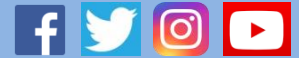

Feeding of Wildlife

DO NOT feed any wildlife – either intentionally or unintentionally. Making food available can attract wildlife to your property, can make them less fearful of humans, and make them accustomed to food provided by humans.

Some suggestions to help keep wildlife away from your property:

- Properly store garbage in containers. Put garbage at curbside the morning of collection and not overnight.
- Ensure bird seed is in a bird feeder.

The minimum set fine under By-Law No. 41-2015 for the *intentional feeding of wildlife or making available food attractants or other substances for the consumption of wildlife*, is a minimum of \$300.00 per offence.

Updated Property Values - 2020

Every four years, the Municipal Property Association (MPAC) sends out a Property Re-Assessment Notice to all Ontario property owners. Property Re-Assessment Notices will be mailed from May to September, and will reflect the updated value of your property as of January 1, 2020. Municipalities will use your assessment to calculate your 2021-2024 property taxes.

When you receive your Notice, review it and keep it for your records.

For more information visit mpac.ca and log onto AboutMyProperty, an online tool to:

- Learn how your property was assessed
- See the information MPAC has on file for your property
- Compare your assessed value to other similar properties in your area
- File a Request for Reconsideration if you disagree with your property's assessed value

**NOTICE OF PUBLIC MEETING
FOR AN OFFICIAL PLAN AMENDMENT, FILE NUMBER D09-20-01
ZONING BY-LAW AMENDMENT, FILE NUMBER D14-20-01**

TAKE NOTICE that the Council of The Corporation of the Municipality of Red Lake is proposing to amend the Official Plan and Zoning By-Law. The amendments to the Zoning By-Law entail: revisions to definitions and general provisions related to public use; and changes to the Official Plan to add general policies regarding public use.

TAKE NOTICE that the proposed amendments under the above file numbers will be heard by the Planning Advisory Committee (PAC) of The Corporation of the Municipality of Red Lake on the date, and at the time and place shown below. The Council of the Municipality of Red Lake will consider a decision regarding the Official Plan Amendment and Zoning By-Law Amendment at their regular meeting following this public meeting or at a special meeting (which shall be advertised as per the Notice By-Law).

PUBLIC MEETING: You are entitled to attend this public meeting in person to express your views about the proposed amendments. If you are aware of any person interested in or affected by this proposal who has not received a copy of this notice you are requested to inform that person of this meeting. If you wish to make written comments, they may be forwarded to the Clerk of The Corporation of the Municipality of Red Lake at the address below.

FAILURE TO MAKE ORAL OR WRITTEN SUBMISSION: If a person or public body does not make oral submissions at a public meeting or make written submissions to the Council of The Corporation of the Municipality of Red Lake before the by-law is passed:

- a) the person or public body is not entitled to appeal the decision of the Council of The Corporation of the Municipality of Red Lake to the Local Planning Appeal Tribunal.
- b) the person or public body may not be added as a party to the hearing of an appeal before the Local Planning Appeal Tribunal unless, in the opinion of the Board, there are reasonable grounds to do so.

Appeal of a decision of the Council of The Corporation of the Municipality of Red Lake in respect of this proposed Amendment to the Official Plan and Zoning By-Law, may be made by any person or public body not later than 20 days after notice of the decision is given.

NOTICE OF DECISION: If you wish to be notified of the decision of the Council of The Corporation of the Municipality of Red Lake in respect of the proposed Official Plan Amendment and Zoning By-Law Amendment, you must make a written request to The Corporation of the Municipality of Red Lake at the address shown below.
