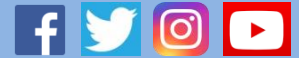

Notice – Snow or Ice By-Law

NOTICE is hereby given of Council's intention to amend By-Law 935-07, being a By-Law to regulate the depositing of snow or ice within the Municipality of Red Lake at its Regular Meeting of Council to be held on Tuesday, February 18th, 2020 at 6:00 p.m. The proposed amendments is as follows:

The addition of "No person shall deposit, or cause to be deposited, snow or ice within a radius of 1.5 meters of a fire hydrant."

The purpose of this amendment is to prevent the piling of snow or ice on or around a fire hydrant in order to ensure fire hydrants are accessible during emergency situations.

A copy of the proposed amended By-Law is available for inspection at the Municipal Office, Monday to Friday, between the hours of 8:30 a.m. and 4:30 p.m. or on the municipal website at www.redlake.ca.

Are you planning to build this Spring?

Construction season is fast approaching! Depending on the development being considered, approval of a planning application may be required in order to obtain a building permit.

The timeframe required for circulation and review of a planning application can be 2 to 6 months. If you are considering to renovate, build or have a development project planned for the 2020 year, it is recommended that you submit your application early.

Nature Trading – bring in your treasures (ie. Interesting rocks, pine cones, shells, fossils, pictures of animals, etc.) and trade for items in our collection. (Open Monday through Friday from 10 am – 4:30 pm)

Ceramics Program – features both a natural science and archeological approach to clay as both a mineral and its historic significance to the creation of indigenous ceramics. Students are given the opportunity to handle the and work with the clay bodies to better understand the malleability and elasticity of clay. Students are also given the option to practice techniques in indigenous ceramics.

Fur Trade Program – provides information about the fur trade including the history and significance of the fur trade industry specific to Red Lake. Includes a practical component.
