NOTICE OF PUBLIC MEETING FOR AN OFFICIAL PLAN AMENDMENT, FILE NUMBER D09-20-02 ZONING BY-LAW AMENDMENT, FILE NUMBER D14-20-02

TAKE NOTICE that the Council of The Corporation of the Municipality of Red Lake is proposing to amend the Official Plan and Zoning By-Law. The amendments to the Zoning By-Law entail: revisions to the Additional Provisions of the lands zoned Mineral Mining (MM), in particular Section 18.3(a) Accessory Residential Uses (dormitories); and changes to the Official Plan to amend section 3.10 Dormitories.

TAKE NOTICE that the proposed amendments under the above file numbers will be heard by the Council of The Corporation of the Municipality of Red Lake on the date, and at the time and place shown below. The Council of the Municipality of Red Lake will consider a decision regarding the Official Plan Amendment and Zoning By-Law Amendment at their regular meeting following this public meeting or at a special meeting (which shall be advertised as per the Notice By-Law).

FAILURE TO MAKE ORAL OR WRITTEN SUBMISSION: If a person or public body does not make oral submissions at a public meeting or make written submissions to the Council of The Corporation of the Municipality of Red Lake before the by-law is passed:

- the person or public body is not entitled to appeal the decision of the Council of The Corporation of the Municipality of Red Lake to the Local Planning Appeal Tribunal.
- the person or public body may not be added as a party to the hearing of an appeal before the Local Planning Appeal Tribunal unless, in the opinion of the Tribunal, there are reasonable grounds to do so.
