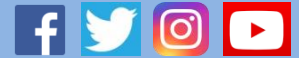

## Fire Permit Reminder

Fire permits are required for burning within municipal boundaries during the annual fire season (April 1<sup>st</sup> – October 31<sup>st</sup>). The conditions of By-Law 38-2018 shall be complied with and fire permits shall be purchased. There is to be NO DAY BURNING during the fire season.

In accordance with the User Fees and Charges By-Law the fees for fire permits are as follows: Annual Permit - \$40/season; 4 Day Permit - \$10/permit; Incinerator Permit - \$50/season; Level 3 Permit - \$400/season; Inspection Fee - \$35.

## Emergency Registration Form

The Corporation of The Municipality of Red Lake invites residents who require **special assistance** to participate in providing valuable information to the Municipality in the event of a Community Emergency.

Examples of those that are **most vulnerable in an emergency situation**:

- the elderly;
- disabled;
- special medical requirements;
- live alone and no local support network; and/or
- lack of transportation.

**The Clerk's Office maintains a listing of the Emergency Registration Forms. If you completed an Emergency Registration Form in 2018 or 2019, you are not required to complete another one, unless your information requires an update.**
